

# I LOVE YARN DAY



## GRANNY SQUARE SCARF

Basic / De base / Básico

### MATERIALS



Medium-weight acrylic yarn in at least 2 colors

Hook size: I/9/5.5mm or size necessary to obtain gauge. Yarn needle

### FINISHED SIZE:

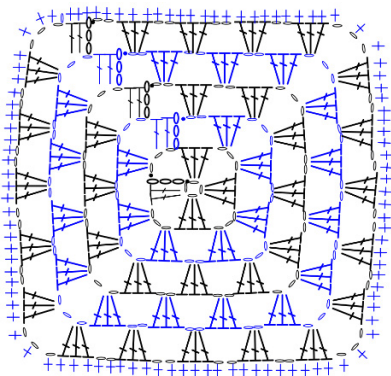


7" x 49" (18 x 124 cm)

### GAUGE



13 stitches = 4 inch (10 cm)



Motif (make 7)

**Row 1:** Ch 4, sl st to 4th ch from hook to form ring, ch 3, 2 dc in ring, ch 3, 3 dc in ring, ch 3, 3 dc in ring, ch 3, 3 dc in ring, ch 3, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Row 2:** With new color, join to any ch-3 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, ch 3, 3 dc in the same sp as the other stitches, [ch 2, (3dc, ch 3, 3dc) in next ch-3 sp] rep 3 times, ch 2, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Row 3:** With new color, join to any ch-3 sp, 2 dc in same sp, ch 3, 3 dc in the same sp as the other stitches, [ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, (3dc, ch 3, 3dc) in next ch-3 sp] rep 3 times, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Row 4:** With new color, join to any ch-3 sp, 2 dc in same sp, ch 3, 3 dc in the same sp as the other stitches, {[ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp] twice, ch 2, (3dc, ch 3, 3dc) in next ch-3 sp} rep 3 times, [ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp] twice, ch 2, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Row 5:** With new color, join to any ch-3 sp, 2 dc in same sp, ch 3, 3 dc in the same sp as the other stitches, {[ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp] rep 3 times, ch 2, (3dc, ch 3, 3dc) in next ch-3 sp} rep 3 times, [ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp] rep three times, ch 2, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Row 6:** With new color, join to any ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 sc in same sp, sc in each stitch around, sl st to join, fasten off. Seam squares together to form scarf. Weave in ends.

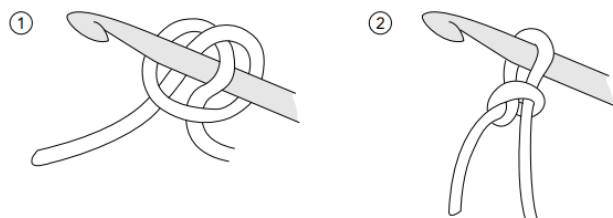
# LEARN TO CROCHET



## SKILLS NEEDED FOR THIS PROJECT:

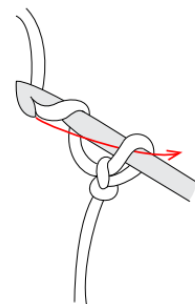
### SLIP KNOT:

Create pretzel shape with yarn end. Insert hook from right to left under internal bar leading to yarn ball (**Figure 1**), pull up loop on hook and tighten knot (**Figure 2**).



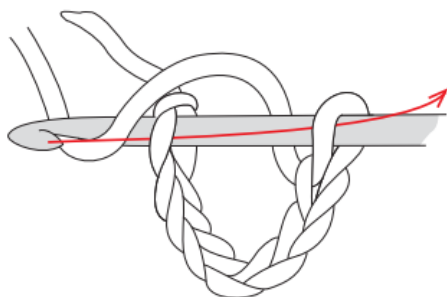
### CHAIN:

Yarn over, draw loop through loop on hook.



### WORKING IN THE ROUND (FORM RING):

Crocheting in the round is used for working items that are not worked in rows, such as cowls, hats, granny squares, etc. To work in the round, turn a foundation chain into a ring by working the number of chains indicated in the pattern, then, taking care not to twist the chain, insert the hook from the front to the back through the first chain, yarn over, draw through the chain and the loop on the hook.



### DOUBLE CROCHET:

Yarn over, insert hook in stitch or chain (**Figure 1**), yarn over, pull up a loop (**Figure 2**), yarn over, draw through 2 loops (**Figure 3**); rep from " once (**Figure 4**). Completed stitch (**Figure 5**).
